The Humber River Footbridge in Toronto, Ontario is near Lake Ontario and is frequently used as the setting for film shoots. The Park Bridge in Kicking Horse Canyon, British Columbia is a project that was featured in television ads promoting British Columbia’s 150th Anniversary as Being One of the Great Modern Icons of the Province. The Mimico Creek Footbridge is a beautiful bridge in Toronto, Ontario, which was designed by Dr. Santiago Calatrava and engineered by Delcan. The Corktown Footbridge in Ottawa also won the Ottawa Urban Design Awards’, Award of Excellence in 2007.
