# Compliance Audit – Denver Transportation Expansion Project (T-REX)

## Project Description

The T-Rex project by the Colorado Department of Transportation and the Regional Transportation District was an improvement of 17 miles of two interstate highways, plus the addition of 19 miles of new Light Rail Transit that included 13 new stations. The LRT line, which connects to the Central Corridor line, provides service to downtown Denver, and to the Southwest Corridor line which serves Englewood and Littleton. Planned highway improvements included additional lanes on I-25 and I-225. The project was delivered under a design-build contract.

## Scope of Services

An integrated management team, called the T-REX Team, composed of personnel from CDOT, RTD, Carter Burgess, Delcan and others, was responsible for the implementation of the contract. The team required an objective, cost-effective system of monitoring the design-builders' compliance with the contractual requirements to assist the team in successfully implementing the contract and to provide optimal value for money to the State of Colorado. Delcan provided Compliance Audit services to the project which included assisting with defining the project requirements, reviewing the proposals, defining the compliance audit approach, and designing, implementing and maintaining the compliance audit system for the duration of this \$1.6 billion project through to its completion in 2006.
