Union Station Rail Corridor (USRC) Improvement Program

Scope of Services

After acquiring the station and associated track, GO Transit required a team to assist in the revitalization of this key asset. The work includes upgrades to platforms and concourses, replacement of the antiquated signal system and upgrade of the track in the Union Station Rail Corridor (USRC).



Project Description:

Delcan, as part of the HDI Joint Venture, was retained to manage the revitalization program. Work to date has included upgrades to several of the platforms to allow GO Transit to consolidate operations and improve passenger access and accommodate VIA Rail in the southern half of the station.



Design and construction management tasks have been undertaken in parallel with long range planning, and design of a state-of-the-art signal system is also underway. The challenges of upgrading a major railway terminal while maintaining full operations, combined with the needs of multiple stakeholder and the exacting standards of GO Transit combine to make this a complex program.

Results:

Incremental improvements in station operations will be implemented as work proceeds. The ultimate goal is to provide GO Transit with the capacity to handle a doubling of passenger traffic, which is predicted to happen over the next 20 years.
