**Spadina Link Project Managers Team (a joint venture of Hatch Mott MacDonald, Delcan and MMM Group) wins \$100,000,000 Project Management services contract for the Spadina Subway Extension**

Toronto, Canada, March 26, 2008 – *Spadina Link Project Managers*, a joint venture of Hatch Mott MacDonald, Delcan, and MMM Group, has been awarded the seven-year, \$100 million Project Management Services contract for the Spadina Subway Extension by the Toronto Transit Commission.

With an estimated final cost of \$2.63 billion, the Spadina Subway Extension is the largest transit expansion project to be undertaken by the TTC in 40 years, since the Bloor-Danforth Subway line was built. This infrastructure initiative is sponsored by three levels of government - Government of Canada, Province of Ontario and City of Toronto/York Region. The project is unique in that the TTC subway network will go beyond the City of Toronto limits for the first time and link neighbouring communities in York Region.

The 8.6 km extension to the existing Spadina subway line will be underground, and will add six more stations, including a new station at York University. The project is expected to commence in April 2008 with an anticipated completion in 2015.

The three firms that make up the *Spadina Link Project Managers* joint venture have been working with the TTC over the past 50 years providing engineering, and project and construction management consulting services.
